The Biological Threat Reduction Program improves biological laboratory safety and security, funds cooperative biological research, and implements an integrated human and animal laboratory-based disease surveillance system. While at SAIC, she led the development of 65 Cooperative Biological Research projects in five former Soviet republics. She also worked for Life Technologies as a research associate where she developed molecular biology products for life science research.

Ms. Long-Wagar has a B.A. (double major) in anthropology and biology from Grinnell College, a Sc.M. in molecular microbiology and immunology with a certificate in vaccine science and policy from the Johns Hopkins University Bloomberg School of Public Health, and a M.P.H. in global health promotion with a certificate in epidemiology from the George Washington University School of Public Health and Health Services.
